New Delhi: City-based e-governance firm MGRM has tied up with card solutions provider headquartered in the Netherlands, to tap en in e-governance and identity management verticals in India.

The joint venture will become operational in the next quarter or a formalities are completed, MRGM said in a statement.

"This is a 50:50 joint venture, and combines strengths of both MG MGRM group founder K.V.R. Murthy.

While the Rotterdam-based Bell ID is into managing identification diverse geographies, MGRM has developed and managed research applications in different domains in India.
